BOZEMAN, Mont. (June 8, 2021) – Today, Under Canvas announced the return of *Pay What You Can*, the brand's giveback program that began in May 2019. To submit, applicants must answer a brief series of questions and submit a photo of their work identification/badge to be considered for a stay at one of Under Canvas' nine camps, including two

Under Canvas will consider all applications and work with applicants to provide at least 100 two-night stays that will be valid from July 1, 2021 - November 29, 2021 (based on occupancy and availability, holidays and weekends excluded) at a price amenable to their budget, exclusive of all transportation and meals. Since opening the first camp nine years ago near West Yellowstone, Under Canvas has dedicated itself to connecting guests to the outdoors and to each other through experiences that immerse travelers into nature in an inherently spatially distanced way.
