A Private Driving Tour generally stops at a lot of great overlooks of the Grand Canyon, including Grand Canyon Village, Yavapai Point, Mather Point, Grandview Point, Moran Point, Tusayan Ruins, Lipan Point, and Desert View.

Private Hiking is dependent on the desired intensity. For a less intense day, you would do some hiking along the South Rim, but not trek below the Rim. For an intermediate or advanced day, you could hike below the Rim and have a picnic lunch from an amazing overlook. Some Trail options include the Rim Trail, Bright Angel Trail, South Kaibab Trail, Hermit Trail, and Grandview Trail.

## Grand Canyon Jeep Safaris

While the Safari & Rim Walk Jeep tour and the Sunset Jeep tour do go to different areas, they are quite similar; we would recommend only doing one.

### Jeep Safari & Rim Walk

During the tour you will travel via 4x4 through the Kaibab National Forest before strolling along the rim of the Grand Canyon. Your guide will be sure to entertain you with the fascinating history, geology, and local folklore of the region. Look through all types of wildlife from elk and deer to bobcats, turkeys, and hawks. After, you will enter historic Grand Canyon Village where you will park and start the walking tour.

### Sunset Jeep Tour

Venture down old stagecoach trails through Kaibab National Forest. During this trip, there are massive amounts of wildlife present from deer to elk to turkey and more. Sunset hour at the Grand Canyon is magical so get ready to view the amazing vistas and unique geological formations while spending quality time with your friends and family.

## Bike Tours

### Hermit Road Bike Tour

This bike tour takes you along a portion of the historic Hermit Road, winding along the Canyon Rim for 6 miles and is closed to public vehicles. It boasts some of the grandest views along the South Rim. Not to mention the safest for families wanting to explore the South Rim by bike. After boarding the shuttle, you bypass the uphill section and start at Hopi Point. From there the tour proceeds westward for 5.5 miles (9 km) of easy riding; stopping at jaw-dropping lookouts along the way to take in the sights and hear interesting information about the natural and human history. The tour ends at Hermit's Rest; take your picture with the historic bell at the entrance to the 1914 Mary Jane Colter building.

### Yaki Point Bike Tour

This bike tour departs and follows a greenway section in the Park eastward to Yaki Point. The beautifully paved paths are designed to let you experience the Canyon Rim at a close distance, while still staying safe. Half a mile into the tour, you emerge into a clearing that offers your first spectacular view of the Grand Canyon. From there, the path winds like a river almost to Yaki Point lookout. Your guide takes you through a colorful history of geology, plant life and human history along the way. Wildlife is commonly seen in this area. This tour is great for all ages and ability levels.
