See Norris Geyser Basin, the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone and its waterfalls, stunning peaks, premier wildlife spotting at Lamar Valley, Blacktail Plateau, Mammoth Hot Springs, the Gardiner & Madison River, Obsidian Cliff, & more.

Lower Loop | Visit the most iconic attractions in Yellowstone National Park, including Artists Paint Pots, Grand Canyon of Yellowstone, Hayden Valley, Yellowstone Lake, the Continental Divide, Old Faithful, Upper & Midway Geyser Basin, & more.

Conveniently close to camp, these rides will take you to awe at views of Hebgen Lake, the Continental Divide, the city of West Yellowstone, and Yellowstone National Park!

Morning Ride | This ride will take you high enough into the mountains to see the beautiful rolling range of the surrounding ranches, Hebgen Lake, the Continental Divide, city of West Yellowstone, and Yellowstone National Park.

Afternoon Ride | *2 Hour or 3 Hour* | Bring your camera as the scenery is stunning, and you won't want to miss the occasional elk, moose, or deer. You'll see Blue Grouse, geese, ducks, ravens, hawks & Sand Hill Cranes.

Evening Ride | The evening rides are very relaxing. This ride is a bit shorter, but is just as stunning as the morning and afternoon tours. Because of cooler weather, new kinds of animals will be more apparent on this ride. The evening ride is peaceful and serene on the shady trails as guests listen to the creak of the saddle beneath them.
